3 Dimensions to build a culture of peace and create positive change

The MoP revolves around 3 educative objectives:

Personal Change - Starts with me

Develop of peace culture and attitude which incorporates into my daily life. To commit in positive change through my action and promote a peace culture

Community Based Change – In my community

Taking up active roles in the community and joining efforts with others to address local issue.

Collective Result – When working together

To promote international cooperation, friendship and understanding through sharing ideas with others.

The Messengers of Peace Learning Cycle

1. Inspire

Explore and Research about local problems, people in action, and good practices.

2. Learn & Decide

Identify your motivations and talents. Choose a field of action. Select useful knowledge, and skills and ideas to apply.

3. Do

Plan your actions, execute, monitor, and report.

4. Share

Share what you did, your experiences, and outcomes, and learnt outcomes.

1. Cub Scout section (7 -11 years)// After completion of the Silver Star

The examiner to inspire guide & help the Cub Scout in doing this badge at every stage.

1. Inspire

Cub Scout can be inspired in one of the following ways

- Observe a Messengers of Peace event or activity organized at Cub pack, Scout troop, District or National level
- Watch a documentary/ listen to a speech related to MoP facilitated by District MoP Coordinator/ ADC Program/ ADC cubs / Cub Scout Leader

2. Learn & Decide

- Learn and decide on a possible project that Cub Scout would like to be involved in. (The subject matter should be in relation to an experience that inspired the Cub Scout), which covers one or more Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- Give a verbal statement to Cub Scout Leader regarding the Project plan (Happy service)
- Cub Scout Leader shall submit proposal format through the ADC cubs/ ADC Program to District Messengers of Peace Coordinator (Proposal format is annexed)

3. Do

• <u>Organize</u> the selected happy service project, spending no less than two (2) service hours of individual contribution with the participation of members of the Cub pack (as the organizer of the project)

AND

• <u>Participate</u> two happy service projects, spending no less than four (4) service hours of individual contribution with the Cub pack

4. Share

- Share the success story of the project by verbal statement to the Cub Scout Leader
- Cub Scout Leader / Examiner shall share the story via www.scout.org website (mandatory)
 & submit the specimen form (report) to the District Messengers of Peace Coordinator through ADC Cubs.
- In the absence of District MoP coordinator, submit the specimen form (report) to the ADC Programme through ADC Cubs.

Awarding

With the Recommendation of relevant District officials, District MoP Coordinator shall submit the specimen form to the National Head Quarters & National MoP Core team will issue the Messengers of Peace Ring badge and the certificate. In the absence of District MoP coordinator, ADC Program will submit the specimen form (report) to the NHQ.

Junior Scout Section (11-14 years and 6 months)

(The examiner to inspire, guide and help the Scout to win this badge)

1. Inspire

Junior Scout can be inspired in one of the following ways

- Observe a Messengers of Peace event or activity organized at Scout Troop, District or National level
- Watch a documentary/ listen to a speech related to MoP facilitated by District MoP Coordinator/ ADC Program / Scout Leader

2. Learn & Decide

- Learn and decide on a possible project that junior Scout would like to be involved in. (The subject matter should be in relation to an experience that inspired the Junior Scout), which covers one or more Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- Give a Soft copy / Scan statement to Scout Leader regarding the Project plan
- Scout Leader shall submit proposal format through the ADC Program to District Messengers of Peace Coordinator (Proposal format is annexed)

3. Do

 Organize the selected service project, spending no less than 18 service hours of individual contribution with the participation of members of the Scout troop (as the organizer of the project)

4. Share

• **Share** the success story of the project via www.scout.org website (mandatory) & submit the specimen form (report) to the District Messengers of Peace Coordinator through ADC Program.

Awarding

With the Recommendation of relevant District officials, District MoP Coordinator shall submit the specimen form to the National Head Quarters & National MoP Core team will issue the Messengers of Peace Ring badge and the certificate. In the absence of District MoP coordinator, ADC Program will submit the specimen form to the NHQ

Senior Scout Section (14 and a half years-18 years)

To be done with the help and guidance of the ADC(Program)/ District MoP Coordinator / Badge Examiner

1. Inspire

Senior Scout can be inspired in one of the following ways

- Observe a Messengers of Peace event or activity organized at Scout Troop, District or National level
- Watch a documentary/ listen to a speech related to MoP facilitated by District MoP Coordinator/ ADC Program / Scout Leader
 - 2. Learn & Decide
 - Learn and decide on a possible project that Senior Scout would like to be involved in. (The subject matter should be in relation to an experience that inspired the Senior Scout), which covers one or more Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
 - Give a Soft copy / Scan statement to Scout Leader regarding the Project plan
 - Scout Leader shall submit proposal format through the ADC Program to District Messengers of Peace Coordinator (Proposal format is annexed)
 - 3. Do
 - Organize the selected service project, spending no less than 24 service hours of individual contribution with the participation of members of the Scout troop (as the organizer of the project)
 - 4. Share
 - **Share** the success story of the project via www.scout.org website (mandatory) & submit the specimen form (report) to the District Messengers of Peace Coordinator through ADC Program.

Awarding

With the Recommendation of relevant District officials, District MoP Coordinator shall submit the specimen form to the National Head Quarters & National MoP Core team will issue the Messengers of Peace Ring badge and the certificate. Rover Scout Section (17 and a half years-26 years)

To be done with the help and guidance of the ADC(Rovers)/ District MoP Coordinator

- Observe a Messengers of Peace event or activity organized at Rover Crew, District or National level
- Watch a documentary/ listen to a speech related to MoP facilitated by District MoP Coordinator/ ADC Program / ADC Rovers / Rover Scout Leader

2. Learn & Decide

- Learn and decide on a possible project that Rover Scout would like to be involved in. (The subject matter should be in relation to an experience that inspired the Rover Scout), which covers one or more Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- Give a Soft copy / Scan statement to Rover Scout Leader regarding the Project plan
- Rover Scout Leader shall submit proposal format through the ADC Rovers to District Messengers of Peace Coordinator (Proposal format is annexed)

3. Do

• <u>Organize</u> the selected service project, spending no less than 32 service hours of individual contribution with the participation of members of the Rover Crew (as the organizer of the project)

4. Share

Share the success story of the project via www.scout.org website (mandatory) & submit the specimen form (report) to the District Messengers of _Peace Coordinator through ADC Rovers.

Awarding

With the Recommendation of relevant District officials, District MoP Coordinator shall submit the specimen form to the National Head Quarters & National MoP Core team will issue the Messengers of Peace Ring badge and the certificate. In the absence of District MoP coordinator, ADC Program will submit the specimen form to the NHQ.

Adult Leaders (18 years and above)

To be done with the help and guidance of the ADC(Training)/ District MoP Coordinator

1. Inspire

Adult Leader can be inspired in one of the following ways

- Observe a Messengers of Peace event or activity organized at Cub pack, Scout Troop, Rover Crew, District or National level
- Watch a documentary/ listen to a speech related to MoP facilitated by District MoP coordinator/ ADC Cubs/ ADC Program / ADC Rovers or any other resource person.

2. Learn & Decide

- Learn and decide on a possible project that Adult Leader would like to be involved in. (The subject matter should be in relation to an experience that inspired the Adult Leader), which covers one or more Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- Give a Soft copy / Scan statement to Scout Leader regarding the Project plan
- Adult Leader shall submit proposal format through the ADC Training to District Messengers of Peace Coordinator (Proposal format is annexed)

3. Do

- <u>Organize</u> the selected service project, spending no less than 32 service hours of individual contribution with the participation of members of the Cub pack/ Scout troop / Rover Crew (as the organizer of the project)
- Mentor and supervise TWO (2) different individual(s) or group(s) through the completion of their Messenger of Peace badges

4. Share

Share the success story of the project via www.scout.org website (mandatory) & submit the specimen form (report) to the District Messengers of Peace Coordinator through ADC Training

Awarding

With the Recommendation of relevant District officials, District MoP Coordinator shall submit the specimen form to the National Head Quarters & National MoP Core team will issue the Messengers of Peace Ring badge and the certificate. In the absence of District MoP coordinator, ADC Program will submit the specimen form to the NHQ.
